

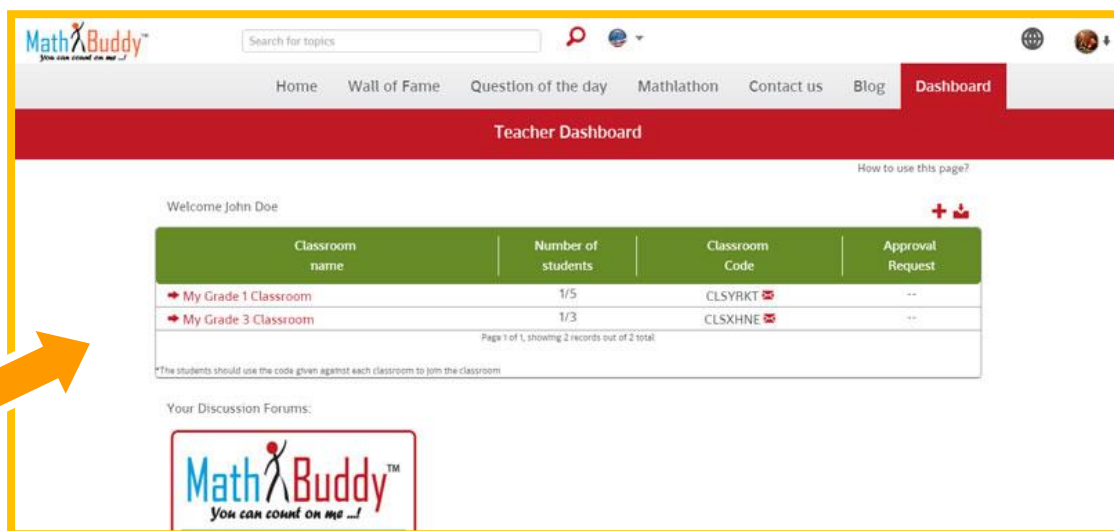
Creating and Managing Personalized Quizzes

You can create good quality quizzes in minutes by selecting questions from the Math Buddy Assessment database. Currently there are more than 7000 good quality multiple choice questions in the assessment database, with each topic in Math containing 60 – 70 questions having 3 different levels of difficulty.

You can create a quiz by selecting questions from the database using a simple interface. The quiz can be assigned to students for taking interactively.

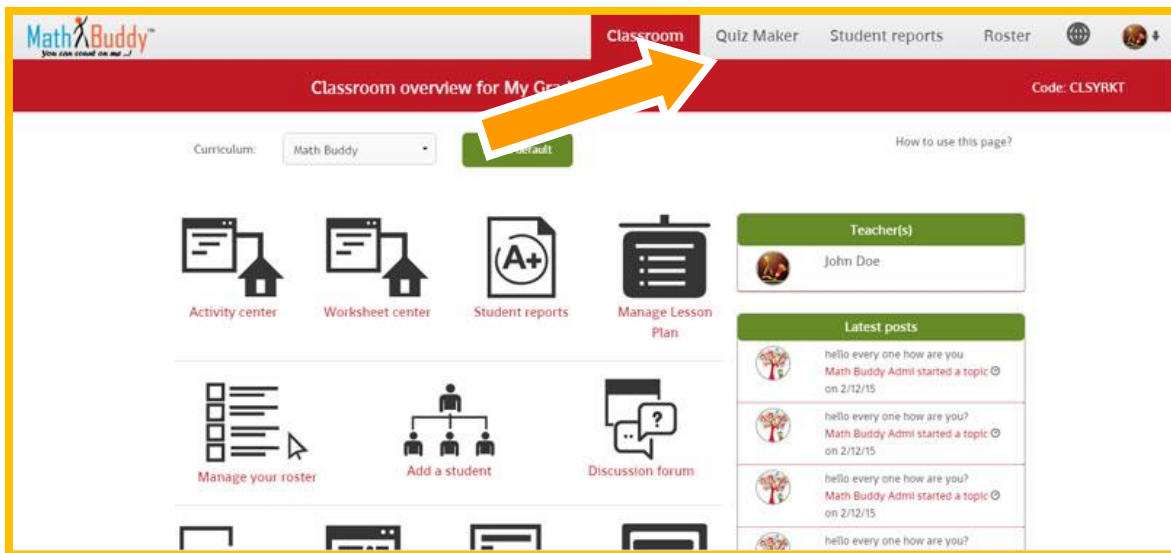
To access this feature,

1. Login to Math Buddy with your Teacher account and click on any classroom from the Dashboard.

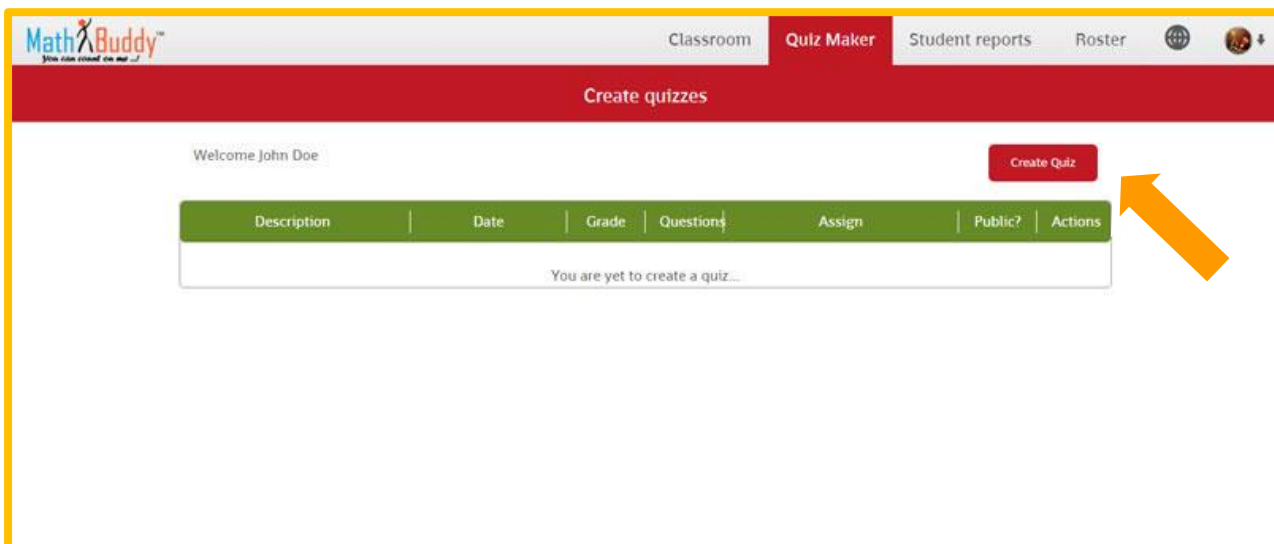


2. You will be taken to the classroom overview for that classroom. Click on Quiz Maker from the top menu.

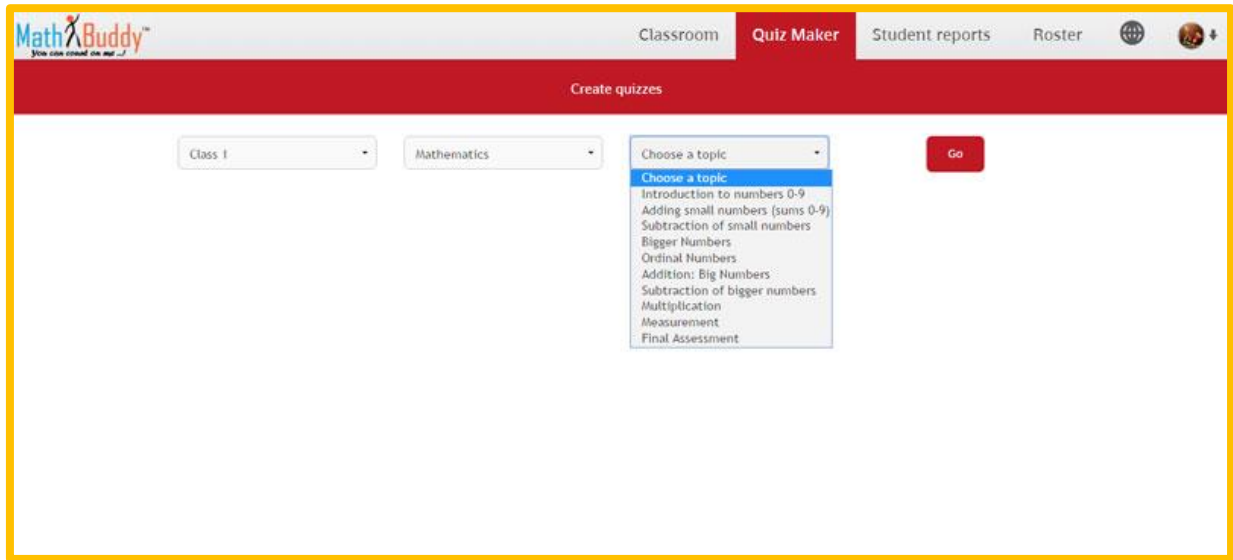


3. This window shows all the quizzes created till date. To create a new quiz, click on the Create Quiz button.

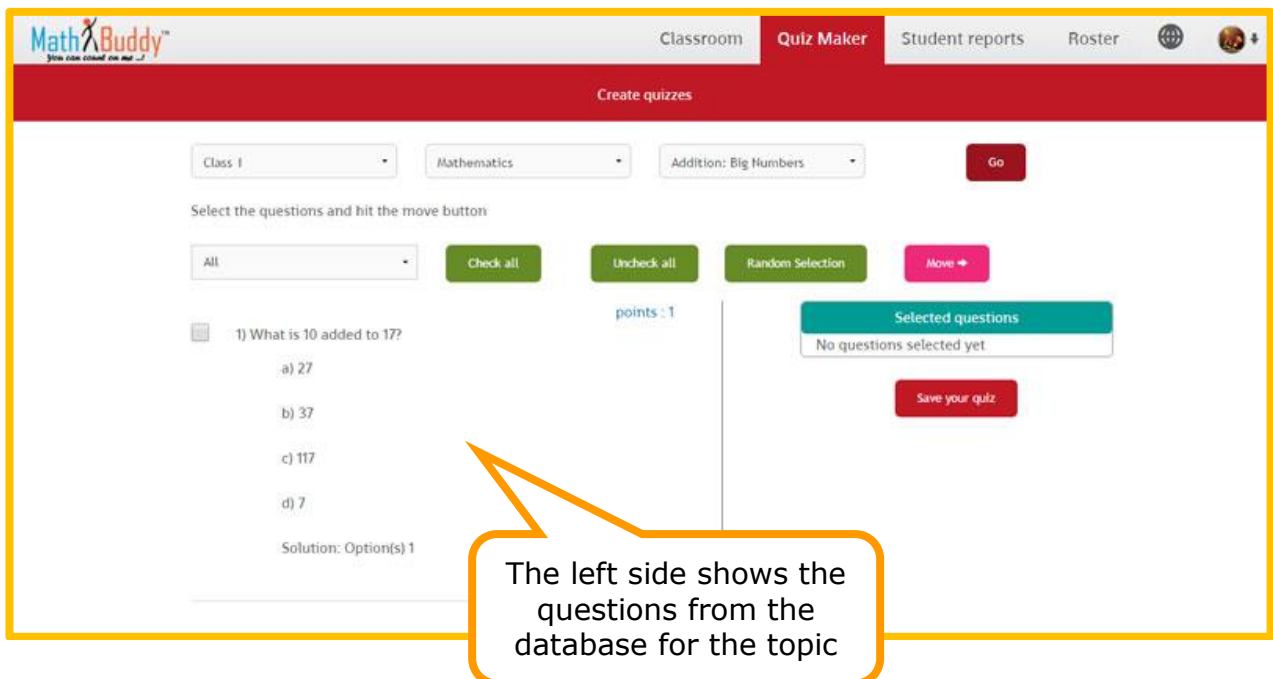


4. Select the grade and the topic for which you would like to select the questions from the pull-down menu.

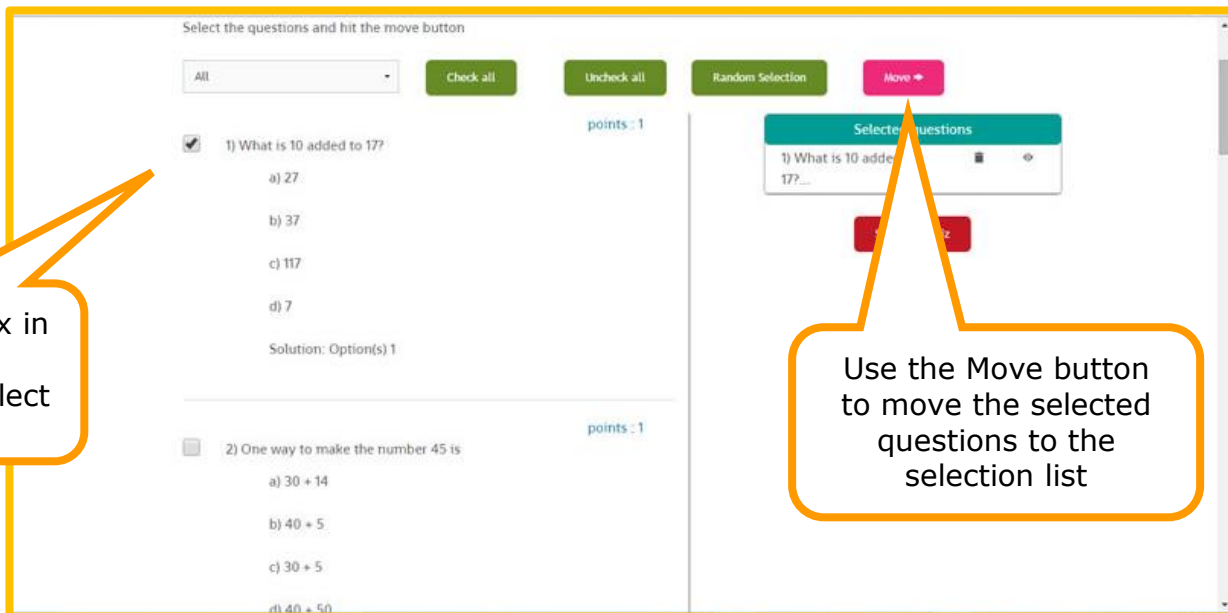
- Once you select a grade and a topic, the questions for the selected topic are shown below. You can scroll down to see all the questions.



- You can go through the questions and select the ones you like by clicking on the square box in front of the question.

Click on the "Move" button to move the questions to the selection list shown on the right.

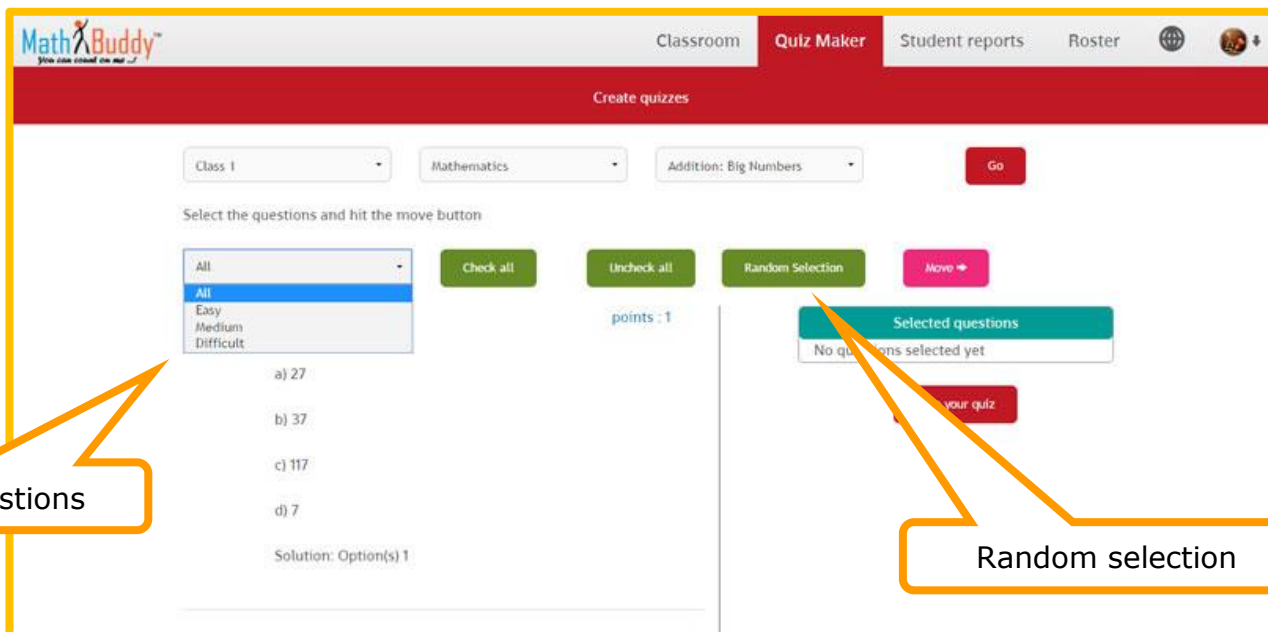

Use the Move button to move the selected questions to the selection list

- You can also filter the questions on the left to show only Easy questions or Medium level difficulty questions or Difficult questions.

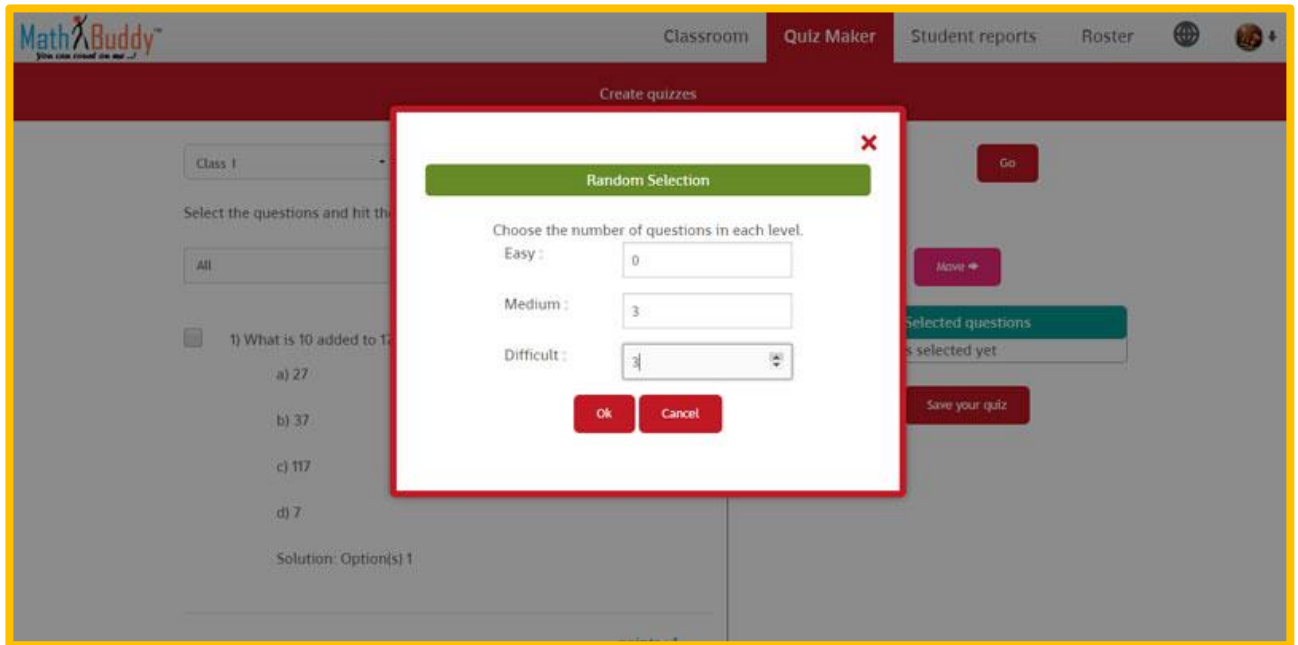


Filter the questions

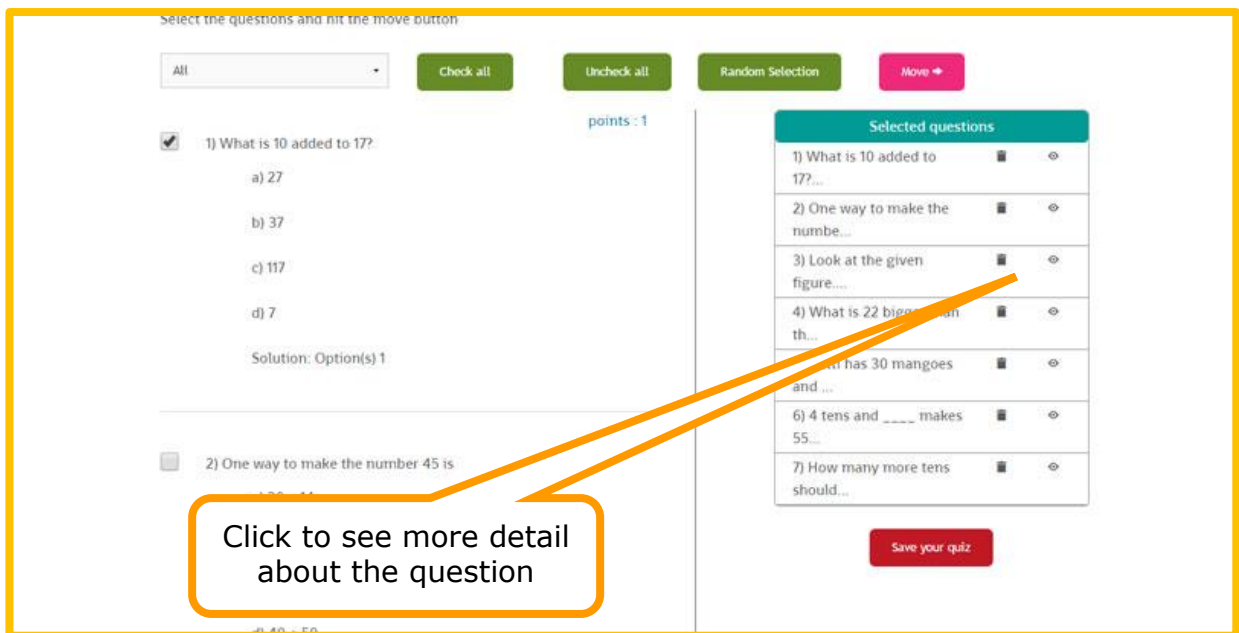
Random selection

- Another important feature is the Random Selection option. You can tell the system to pick questions randomly for you. You can specify the number of Easy, Medium or Difficult questions to select randomly.

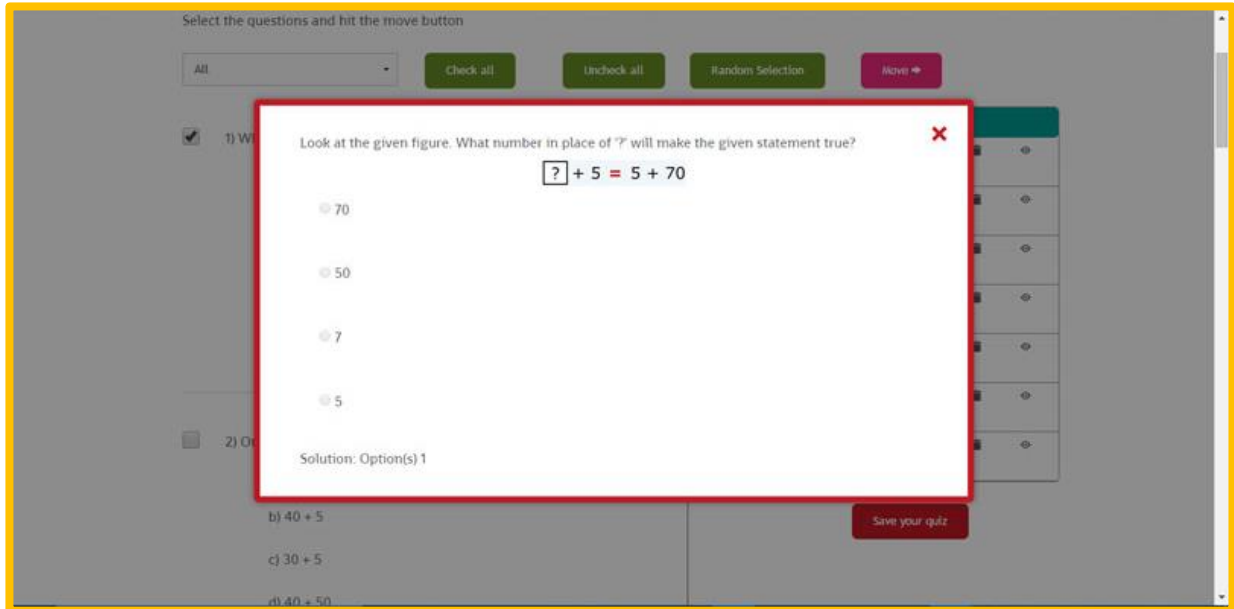


- Once the questions are selected, you can see details about any question by clicking on the eye symbol in front of it in the selection box.



- You will see the question, the choices, the correct answer and an explanation.

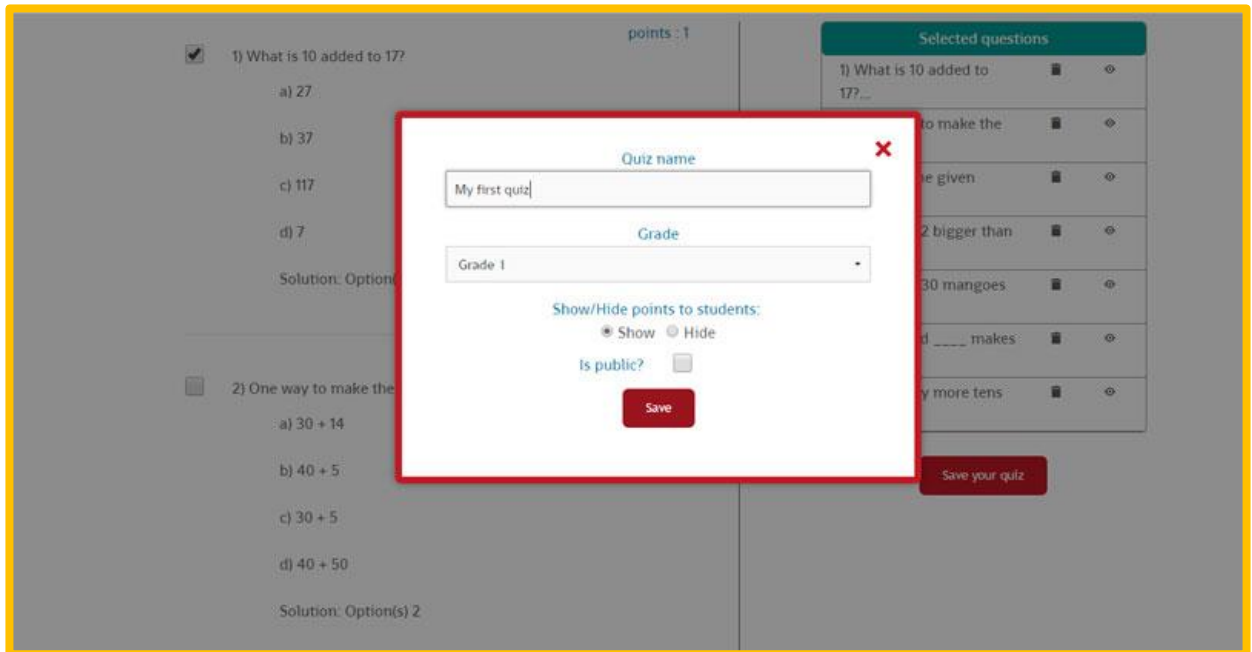

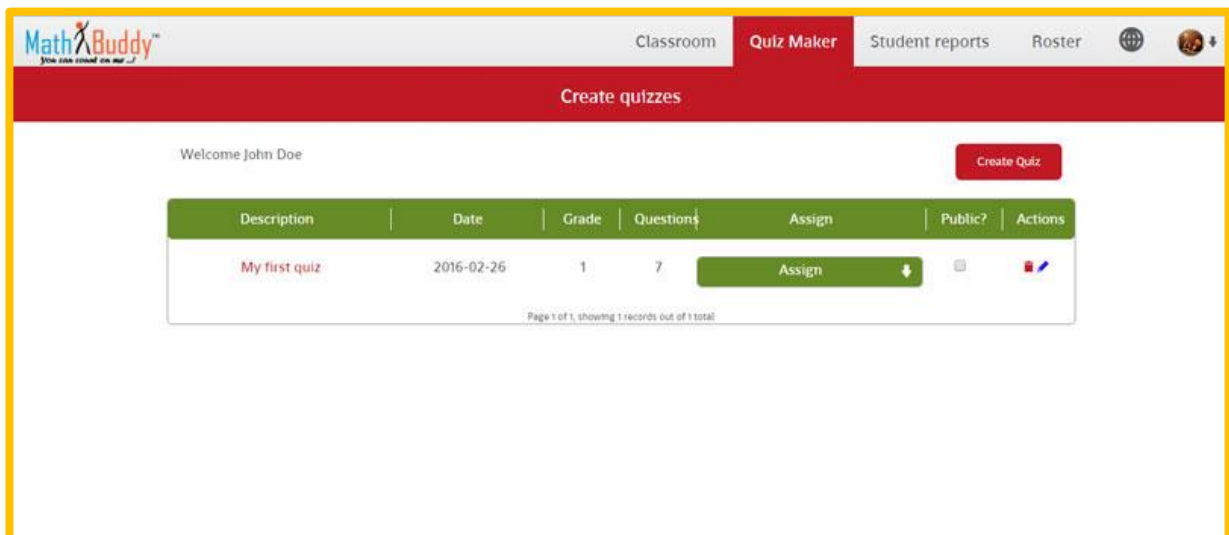
11. Once you are satisfied with the questions, click on “Save your quiz” to save it. Give it a name, select the grade for which it is to be saved and specify whether it should be public (other teachers in your school can access it) or private (only you can access it).

You can also specify if the points for the questions (Easy – 1, Medium – 2 and Difficult – 3) can be shown to the students when they attempt it online.

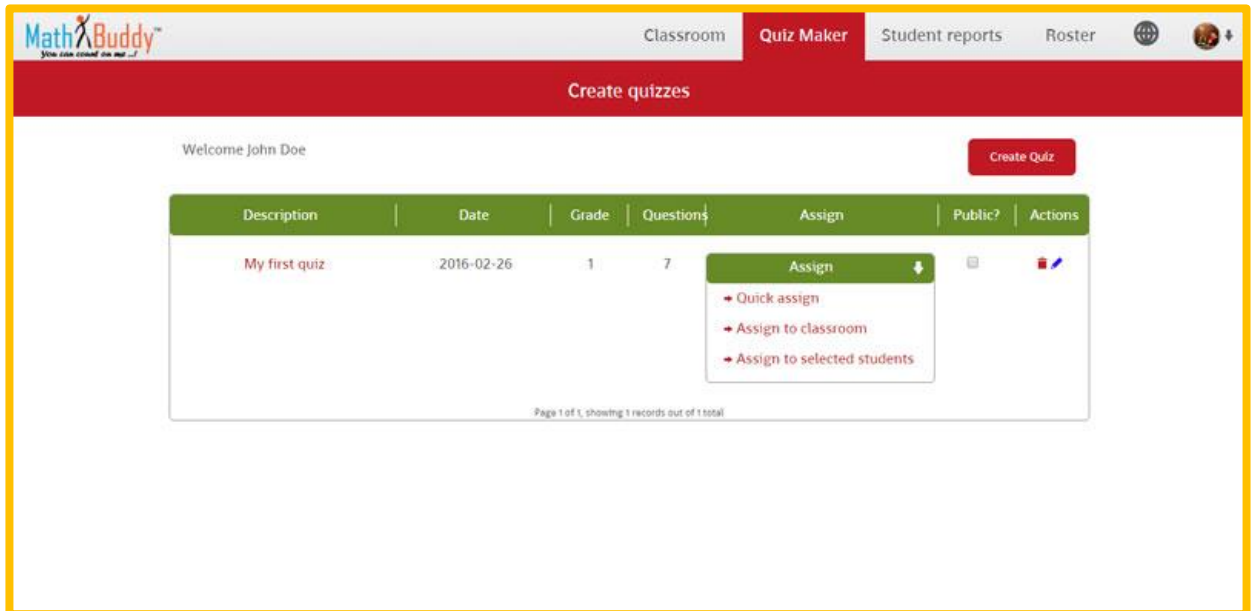


12. Once the quiz is saved, you will see it in the list of quizzes.

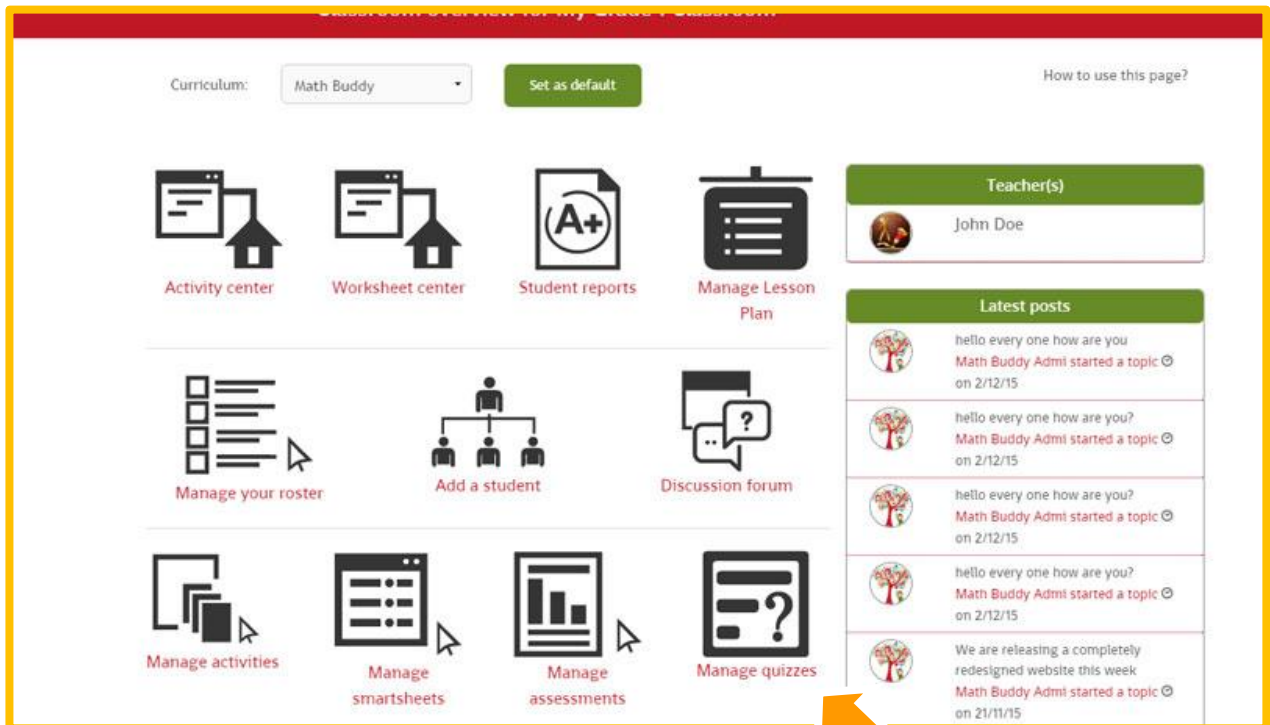


13. From here, you can assign the quiz to students for attempting it online.

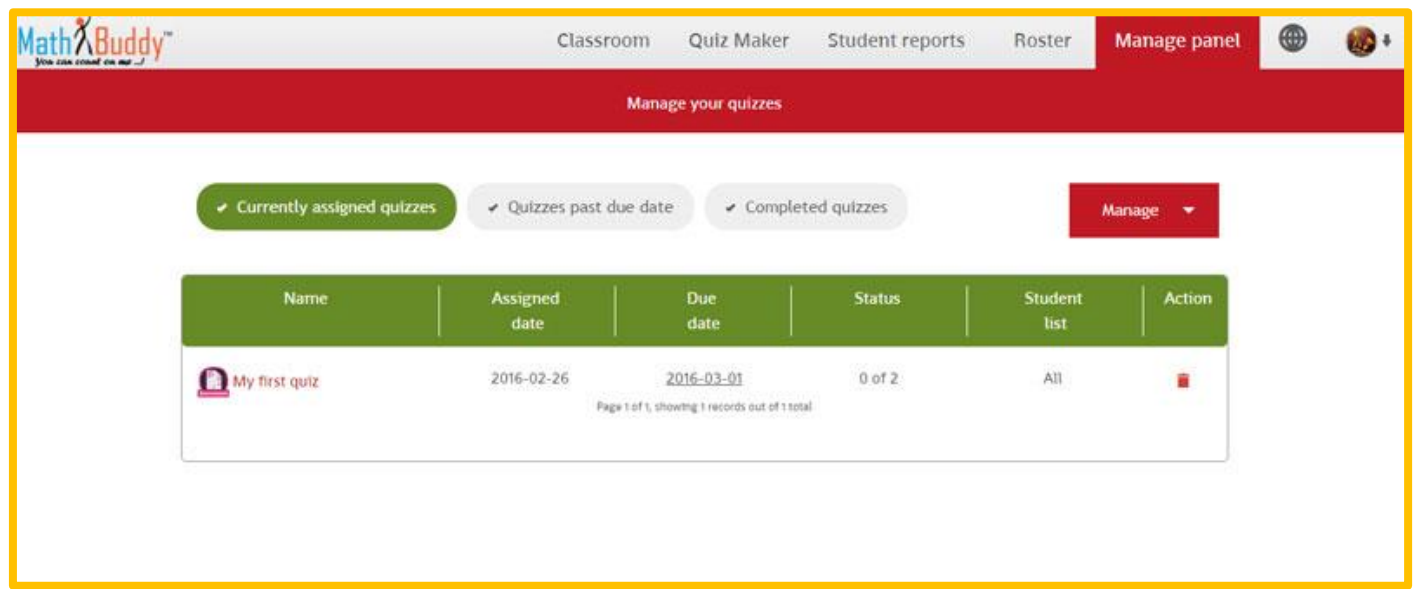


14. Once you assign a quiz, you can manage it from the Classroom Overview page by clicking on Manage Quizzes



Creating and Managing Personalized Quizzes

- Once you assign a quiz, you can manage it from the Classroom Overview page by clicking on Manage Quizzes. You can change the due date, delete the assignment, see how many students have completed the assignment and much more..



Please note the assigned quiz will not show up here once it crosses the due date that was set when the quiz was assigned. You will need to click on Quizzes past due date to see this after it has crossed the due date.

Similarly, the assigned quiz will not show up in this list once all the students complete the quiz. You will be able to see it by clicking on the Completed quizzes button.
